LIBRARY COMMISSION

An amendment to the existing legislation establishing the library study commission has been proposed. The amendment would give the General Assembly the authority to appoint two members to the commission from the general public. The total number of commission members would remain at 21.

If the amendment is approved during the current legislative session Senator Roberts would anticipate convening an organizational meeting of the commission this summer.

A discussion ensued concerning mechanisms for obtaining public input into the work of the commission, surveys, focus groups and public hearings, were suggested.
